



Creative Hands and the Ndebele Legacy (Phase II April-July 2012)

Through the application of the Mobile Training Model, this project focused on the provision of skills to 20 youth in the Mbokota Village of Limpopo for the production of fabric inspired by the Ndebele legacy. This segment of the project represented Phase II which concentrated on the establishment of the Business Incubator, the official launch of the Incubator and the Implementation of the Distribution model for products.





Funded by ABSA Foundation, and held at Elim, Limpopo, other partners included Art Aid, and Limpopo Provincial and Local Government.

Deliverables:

- 30 participants provided with Business Incubators to resume formal business activities.
- Incubators styled into a store and information centre.
- Markets identified for products and orders secured.
- Direct Employment opportunities provided for 30 members of the community.
